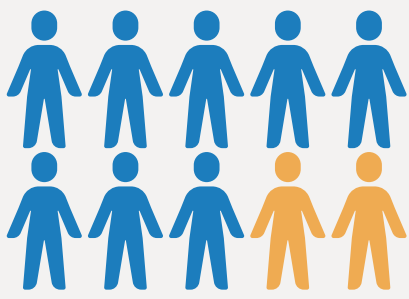
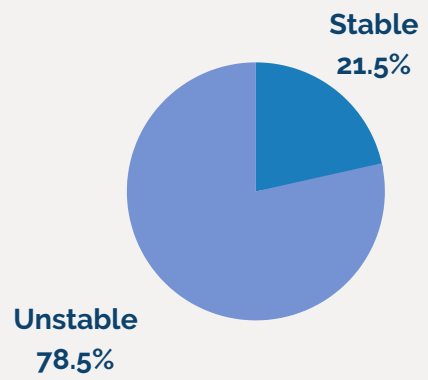

Highlighting Housing Unstable Respondents

Housing Stability

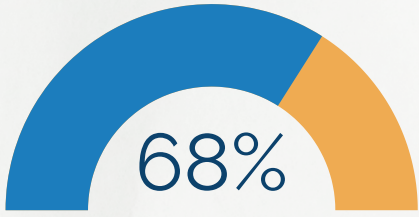
Out of the 214 survey submissions, 46 respondents were found to be housing stable, and 168 were found to be housing unstable.



Gender Identity

Of those who are housing unstable, 83% identified as women and 13% as men.

Results show that 79% identified as heterosexual, 8% as bisexual, 4% as gay, & 1% as queer.



Employment Status

68% of housing unstable respondents are employed.

Employment Type

Of that, 71% are full-time, 15% are part-time, and 5% are casual.

Top Reasons for Housing Insecurity

- I can't afford rent/mortgage payments
- I don't make enough money
- My rent went up
- Illness/medical condition
- Mental health concerns

Overall Service Availability Satisfaction Score



Top Missing Amenities

- Air conditioning
- Home/property insurance
- Sufficient and affordable heating
- Fire protection
- Cooking facilities

Rent vs. Own

Of those who are housing unstable, 29 respondents own their homes and 93 rent.

Shelter Use

61% of respondents did not require shelter services, and 6% reported that the shelter was full. However, others indicated concerns regarding health & safety.
