
Highlighting Housing Unstable Respondents

Housing Stability

Out of the 214 survey submissions, 46 respondents were found to be housing stable, and 168 were found to be housing unstable.



Unstable 78.5%



Gender Identity

Of those who are housing unstable, 83% identified as women and 13% as men.

Results show that 79% identified as heterosexual, 8% as bisexual, 4% as gay, & 1% as queer.



Employment Status

68% of housing unstable respondents are employed.

Employment Type

Of that, 71% are full-time, 15% are part-time, and 5% are casual.

Top Reasons for Housing Insecurity

- I can't afford rent/mortgage payments
- I don't make enough money
- My rent went up
- Illness/medical condition Mental health concerns
