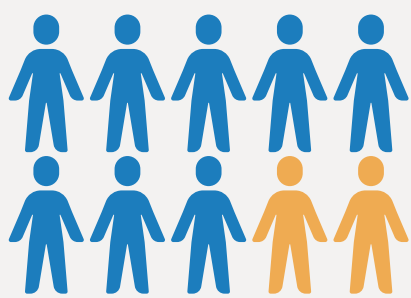
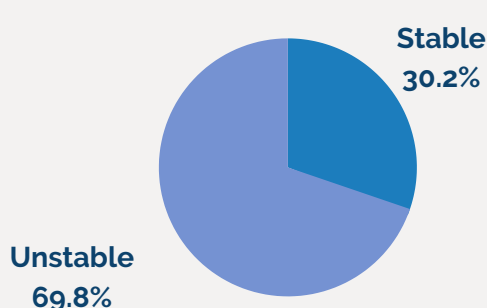

Highlighting Housing Unstable Respondents

Housing Stability

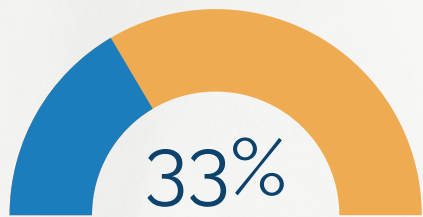
Out of the 43 survey submissions, 13 respondents were found to be housing stable, and 30 were found to be housing unstable.



Gender Identity

Of those who are housing unstable, 77% identified as women, only 17% identified as men and 3% as non-binary.

Results show that 66% identified as heterosexual and, 17% identified as bisexual, & 3% as gay.



Employment Status

33% of housing unstable respondents are employed.

Employment Type

Of that, 29% are full-time, 14% are part-time, and 14% are casual.

*21% indicated 'Other' - retired, seasonally employed, & temp contracts.

Top Reasons for Housing Insecurity

- I can't afford rent/mortgage payments
- I don't make enough money
- House needs major repair
- Illness/medical condition
- Physical disability

Top Missing Amenities

- Air conditioning
- Home/property insurance
- Sufficient & affordable heating
- Safe drinking water
- Fire protection

Rent vs. Own

Of those who are housing unstable, 11 respondents own their home and 9 rent.

Shelter Use

48% of respondents did not require shelter services. However, 9% indicated that there were none in their area, and others had concerns regarding accessibility, health & safety.
