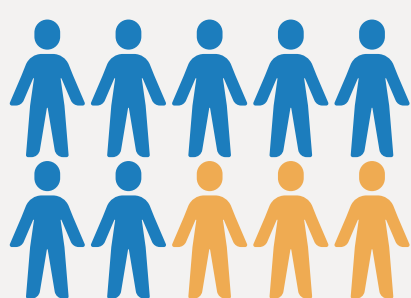
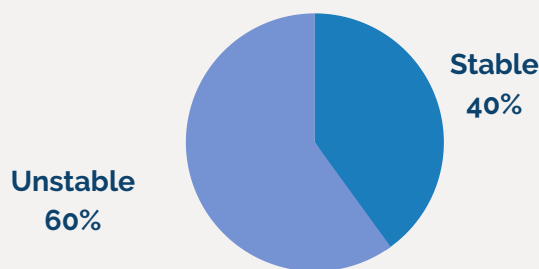

Highlighting Housing Unstable Respondents

Housing Stability

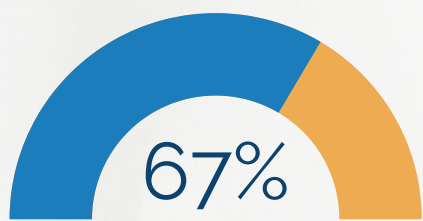
Out of the ten survey submissions, four respondents were found to be housing stable, and six were found to be housing unstable.



Gender Identity

Of those who are housing unstable, 67% identified as women and 33% as men.

Results show that 83% identified as heterosexual and 17% as bisexual.



Employment Status

67% of housing unstable respondents are employed.

Employment Type

Of that, 75% are full-time and 25% are part-time.

Top Reasons for Housing Insecurity

- I don't make enough money
- I can't afford rent/mortgage payments
- My house needs major repair
- Conflict with landlord/partner/family
- Mental/physical disability

Top Missing Amenities

- Air conditioning
- Home/property insurance
- Fire protection
- Access to laundry facilities
- Indoor plumbing /bathing facilities

Rent vs. Own

Three respondents indicated that they own their homes, and two rent.

Shelter Use

83% of respondents did not require shelter services. However, 17% indicated they did not feel safe when attempting to access one.
