


## **Highlighting Housing Unstable Respondents**

### **Housing Stability**

Out of the 110 survey submissions, 33 respondents were found to be housing stable, and 77 were found to be housing unstable.

**Stable** 30% **Unstable** 70%



# **Gender Identity**

Of those who are housing unstable, 65% identified as women, 23% as men and 6% as non-binary.

Results show that 69% identified as heterosexual and, 9% identified as bisexual, & 7% as asexual, gay, and queer.



## **Employment Status**

75% of housing unstable respondents are employed.

### **Employment Type**

Of that, 32% are full-time, 39% are part-time, and 10% are casual.
