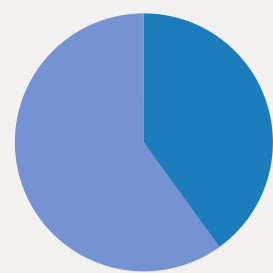

## Highlighting Housing Unstable Respondents

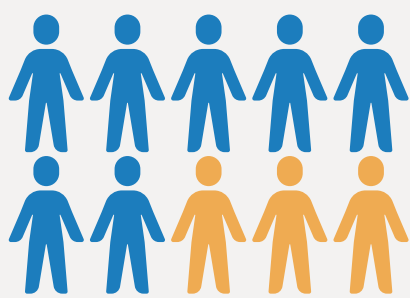
### Housing Stability

Out of the 50 survey submissions, 20 respondents were found to be housing stable, and 30 were found to be housing unstable.

60%



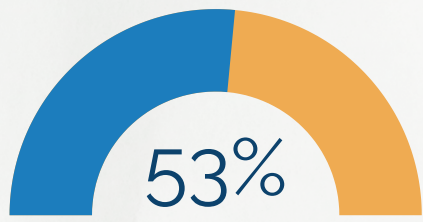
Stable

### Gender Identity

Of those who are housing unstable, 73% identified as women and only 20% identified as men.

Results show that 80% identified as heterosexual and, 7% identified as bisexual, & 3% as asexual.

### Employment Status

53% of housing unstable respondents are employed.

### Employment Type

Of that, 50% are full-time, 33% are part-time, and 6% are casual.

### Top Reasons for Housing Insecurity

- I don't make enough money
- I can't afford rent/mortgage payments
- My house needs major repair
- Mental health concerns
- Illness/medical condition

### Top Missing Amenities

- Air conditioning
- Sufficient & affordable heating
- Home/property insurance
- Fire protection
- Access to laundry facilities

### Rent vs. Own

Of those who are housing unstable, 12 respondents own their homes and 13 rent.

### Shelter Use

54% of respondents did not require shelter services. However, 17% indicated that there were none in their area, and others had concerns regarding health & safety.
